

Internal Board Policies - OrganizationAnnual Organizational Meeting

An organizational meeting of the Holdrege Public School District Board of Education for swearing in of new board members, election of officers, and other business shall be held on or before the third Monday of January of each year and may be held in conjunction with (as a part of) the regular monthly meeting.

1. After new members are sworn in, the Board will elect from its members a President and Vice President and appoint an ex officio secretary and treasurer, all of whom will assume office at the meeting.
2. A board member representative from the nominations committee, appointed prior to this meeting by the President, will present such nominations for consideration.
3. A motion to elect a President to serve a term of one year, or until the person's successor is elected and qualified, shall be considered, with roll call vote. If the motion fails, a second motion may be considered. If no member receives a majority of votes for President after two motions, the previous President shall continue as President. In the event that the previous Board President is no longer a Board member, then the Vice President from the immediately preceding term shall become the President. In the event that both the prior President and Vice President are no longer members of the Board, then the longest tenured Board member shall serve as President.
4. The President shall assume the chair immediately upon the President's election.
5. A motion to elect/appoint the positions of Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer to serve a term of one year, or until the person's successor is elected and qualified, shall be considered, with roll call vote.
6. Under the board committee reports agenda item, the President will review and appoint board standing committees and will confirm the designated method(s) of advance meeting notice.
7. Board members will be provided information and forms for compliance with conflict of interest statutes as needed.
8. Other business such as designation of depository bank(s) or review of current polices and regulations may be included in the agenda as appropriate.
